## Directions to Soyuzivka

### COMING FROM THE NORTH

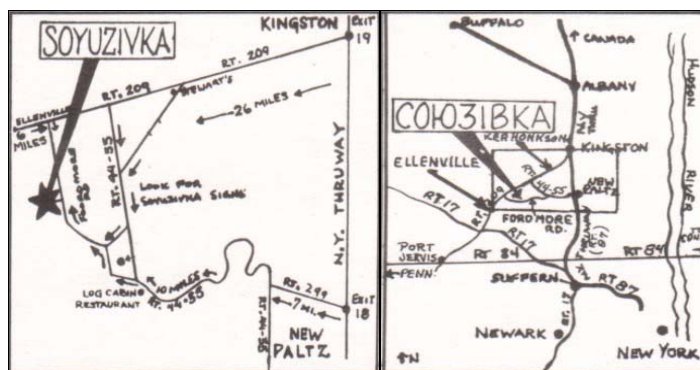
Take New York State Thruway (87 South) to Exit 19—Kingston, make first right at Traffic Circle, continue to Route 209 South towards Ellenville. Continue to 3rd traffic light (Kerhonkson—Stewart's on left), make left. Continue to top of hill. This is 44/55, make left and first right onto Minnewaska Trail. Continue to top of hill (watch for small UNA signs), make first right. At stop sign turn right, this is Foordmore Road, continue for a mile and a half, church is on right, entrance to Soyuzivka is on left.

### COMING FROM THE SOUTH

Take New York State Thruway (87 North) to Exit 18—New Paltz. Turn left onto Rt. 299, continue through New Paltz going straight all the way to end at Rt. 44/55, make right, go past Lake Minnewaska, when you pass the Log Cabin Restaurant, make first left onto Minnewaska Trail, opposite Hudson Valley Resort sign. Bear left onto Foordmore Rd. Continue for a mile and a half, church is on right, entrance to Soyuzivka is on left.

### OR

Take New York State Thruway (Rt. 87 North) to Exit 16—Harriman, on to New Rt. 17 North to Ellenville Exit, # 113. Turn right onto Rt. 209 North, go through Ellenville towards Kerhonkson. Pass Valley Mall on left, continue 2.2 miles, a Heritage Energy Oil Tank is on the right, make first right turn at Soyuzivka sign, this is Foordmore Rd. Continue 1 1/2 miles, church is on left, entrance to Soyuzivka is on right. (From NJ, take Garden State Parkway to Rt. 17).

# While at Soyuzivka...

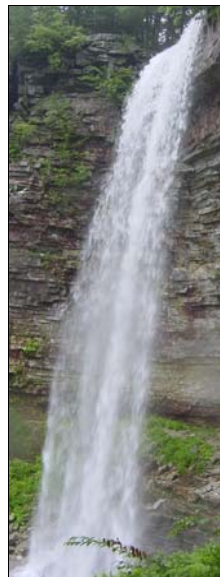
